

# Steps to Create DEB ID

Please make sure you have created your ABC (APAAR) ID ([click here](#) for the guidelines) first before you proceed to create your DEB ID.

## Step 1

Visit the below UGC's Distance Education Bureau website and Input your ABC (APAAR) ID in the box and click on the 'Enter' button: <https://deb.ugc.ac.in/StudentDEBId>
